

CASE STUDY

The Client

The Australian Nanotechnology Network (ANN) is an innovative collaboration created by four seed funding networks. The ANN dedicates itself to bringing together all of the various groups whom are working in the field of Nanotechnology and related areas within Australia. The field of Nanotechnology is becoming one of Australia's fastest growing areas of research and technology.

The Conference:

ICONN 2016 was held over four days in February at the NCC, Canberra and brought together over 600 researchers, industry, students and early career scientists to discuss the latest discoveries in nanotechnology.

ICONN 2016 featured International speakers from the United States, United Kingdom and Germany, with almost 200 international delegates representing Europe, Asia Pacific, Eurasia and North America.

The Role of All Occasions Group (AOG):

Services included full conference management of this 4 day conference. Our team in Melbourne and Adelaide worked tirelessly with the Co-Chairs from the Australian National University (ANU) in Canberra and the Symposia Chairs to develop the complex program featuring plenary talks followed by technical symposia (invited talks, oral and poster presentations). In total, there were 43 speakers, 25 trade exhibitors, 279 poster displays and 9 sponsors contributing in excess of \$70,000.

AOG were also responsible for full financial management of the \$500k + conference budget.

AOG organised the social side of ICONN 2016, commencing with the welcome reception in the exhibition area. This was a great networking opportunity for the students, scientists, engineers and stake holders from academia, government laboratories and industry. Further social opportunities were provided with two happy hours which were combined with the presentation of 279 posters. The final conference dinner, was a highlight with a number of awards presented to speakers, a delicious meal and entertainment to dance the night away.

The post conference survey completed by the Co-Chair, Prof. Chennupati Jagadish from the ANU, rated the AOG conference staff as excellent to outstanding for quality of service, communication, problem solving and attention to detail. He also rated our onsite responsiveness, knowledge and helpfulness as outstanding!
